Dear Parents/Carers

Monthly Voluntary Contributions to SS Peter & Paul School

We are very fortunate to have so many supportive parents at SS Peter and Paul, who contribute regularly through all the various PTFA activities and the PTFA is often approached by parents asking if it is possible to make a regular contribution to the school. We wanted to let you know that it is possible and easy.

You may be aware that SS Peter & Paul School is a **Voluntary Aided School**. This means that the Governing Body is responsible for funding at least 10% of all capital costs for school building maintenance and structural improvements. For large projects the money comes from LCVAP grants which the school applies for. The more money the school can offer towards a project the more likely it is to receive funding.

The Governing Body gets its funding from 3 main sources: the DFE, monies from lettings and donations. The biggest source of income is from donations. These donations are made through the PTFA and are held in a separate PTFA account solely for the benefit of maintaining and improving the school building. If you are a UK tax payer, this has the added bonus of allowing the PTFA to claim Gift Aid on your contribution, increasing your donation by 25%.

Over the next three years the school would like to be able to renew the KS2 toilets and replace the school roof. These two projects will come to over £350,000 which means the Governors need to be able to pay at least £35,000 towards the projects.

If you would like to help the school by making a regular or one-off donation to the school, please complete the attached standing order form and Gift Aid Declaration Form (if you are a UK tax payer and would like us to claim Gift Aid.) Even £5 a month will do a world of good.

We would like to take the opportunity to thank parents who already contribute in this way and in so many other ways, we are keen that you feel under no obligation, these contributions are voluntary.
